



**Magic Breakfast (The National School Breakfast Programme)** We are really pleased to announce that we have joined the government's National School Breakfast Programme which is being delivered by the charities Family Action and Magic Breakfast. This means we will be offering breakfast to everyone! There will be the following opportunities:

- 1) Join our breakfast club each day to enjoy a range of healthy breakfast cereals, bagels and porridge at a cost of £2.50 per session (7.45 – 8.45am)
- 2) Pick up a bagel on the playground – free to all children

We are hoping to launch this on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> March. This is such an amazing opportunity to ensure that every child is ready to learn.
