STARTING SCHOOL – GENERAL INFORMATION

ORDERING A HOT SCHOOL LUNCH FOR YOUR CHILD

All hot lunches should be ordered via Wisepay. To access the login page, please click on the Wisepay logo on the front page of the school's website. If you require a log-in to Wisepay, please contact the School Office.

Free school meals are available to all Key Stage 1 (FS2 Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) children under the Universal Free School Meals Scheme. In addition, parents who are in receipt of specific benefits under the welfare system are also entitled to claim a free school meal for their child and we as a school receive additional funding from central government for every child who is confirmed eligible. It is, therefore, really important to sign up for free school meals, even if your child is in FS2 Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, so that the school receives as much funding as it is entitled to.

Any parent who registers and is confirmed eligible under the welfare system will be entitled to apply for a school uniform grant (currently worth £20 per annum) and a £50 credit payment which can be used to buy additional school uniform or payment towards residential trips, school trips or music lessons.

An application form to register under the welfare system is available to download from our website or alternatively call into the school office to collect a paper copy.

3:15 AFTER SCHOOL CLUB AND BREAKFAST CLUB

At Malmesbury Park, we offer after school childcare as well as a breakfast club for children from FS2 Reception to Year 6.

The cost for each 3:15 after school club session is currently £6.50 per child and must be pre-booked one week in advance. Fees should be paid at the time of booking using the Wisepay link on the school's website. An annual registration fee of £10 per child is also required and must be paid in advance of your child attending their first sessions via the Wisepay link (listed under school activities, 3:15 Club annual registrations fee).

The cost of each breakfast club session, from September 2018, will be £2.50. Sessions must be, once again, pre-booked at least 12 hours in advance with fees paid at the time of booking using the Wisepay link.
