Roles and Responsibilities in Y2

As a school we believe it is vitally important that children are given the opportunity to take on a variety of roles within the school and to understand what it means to be responsible. We have a number of jobs within each year group that children can apply for and undertake for a set period of time.

The jobs have been designed to give them the chance to develop key skills which will be important throughout their life and at the next stage of their academic career, whilst gaining confidence. All children within the year group are eligible to apply for the jobs and will be expected to complete an application form if they decide they wish to take on this responsibility. As part of their initial project the children have applied for and are now undertaking their role. Please remind your children that they will be able to apply each half term for a different or new role.
