WELCOME

We hope you have all had a lovely Summer and want to say a big welcome to all the families joining Nursery this Year.

Every child has a key worker who works with their child in key groups every session. You will be told who this is during their induction visit or in their first week back at school. Mrs Hayes, the Nursery leader, works with all of the children across the week. Other adults work with all of the children on a regular basis. This may be in small groups or 1:1

Our sessions are made up of:

- "Let's Explore" - child initiated play. During this time, the children choose what activity they would like to do. They can choose to be outside or inside.
- Key group. This is an adult-led activity where we spend time focusing on numbers, letters (phonics), developing language and vocabulary, mark making and project work.
- Snack time. This is our social time where we sit in groups and have our fruit and drink.
- Carpet time. We all gather together on the carpet at the start and end of sessions to say hello and to celebrate the children's successes.

Please can you try to remember to ALWAYS have spare pants, socks and clothes in a bag in Nursery. This can remain in Nursery.

All of the Nursery team are available if you have any questions, queries or concerns.

We are very excited to have your child (and you) join us at Malmesbury Park Nursery for what will be a very exciting year.

THIS TERM:

Over the coming term we will be enjoying new projects: "Me", "Autumn", "Room on the Broom" "Light and Dark," "Wheels on the Bus" and "We Wish You A Merry Christmas"

The children will be making new friends, finding out about Nursery, visiting the school woodland, and also finding out about seasonal events and festivals.

We have many books you can borrow to share together at home. These will come home on a Tuesday and can be returned the following week. If your child does not attend Tuesday they will be given a book on a day they do.

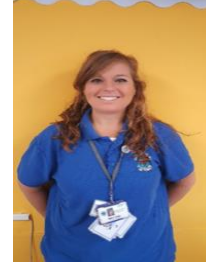
