WELCOME:

A warm welcome to Year 1. We are looking forward to an exciting year of learning with your children. THIS TERM:

We will be completing daily phonics, reading, writing and maths lessons. In Science we will be learning about Everyday Materials before half term and the seasons Autumn and Winter after half term. For Geography we will be finding out about My Local Area. After half term we will be exploring Toys in Time for our History learning.

HOME LEARNING:

Children will bring home a reading book linked to the phonics book they are reading in school. Children can also access books to read at the appropriate level online through Oxford Owl. Reading at home for 10 minutes a day is the best way to support your child. Please record this in your child's reading diary. On a Thursday, children will be set project and maths home learning tasks. These need to be completed and returned the following Wednesday. Home learning will be set on Teams but it is possible to request a paper copy.

- Please make sure your child has a named water bottle to bring to school each day.
- Please name all school uniform.
- The school gates open at 8:35 and all children need to be in school before they close at 8:55.
