**WELCOME:**

A very warm welcome to Year 3. We are looking forward to an exciting year of learning with your children. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to speak to your child's class teacher at the end of the day, or the Year 3 Year Team Leader Mrs Gaunt.

**Indoor P.E. day - Monday (until October half term) Outdoor P.E. day - Wednesday**

On PE days children can continue to come into school in their PE kit. A reminder that PE kit should be black shorts or black jogging bottoms, a plain white round neck t-shirt, a red sweatshirt with school logo and trainers.

**THIS TERM:**

In the first half term, as well as our daily reading, writing and maths lessons we will be learning about skeletons, muscles and nutrition in science. The children will begin by finding out what a human skeleton looks like and the scientific names for the bones in the human body. In geography, we will be understanding the physical landscape and surrounding seas of the UK, where and why people have chosen to settle in certain locations. After half term, we will be looking at rocks and fossils in science. Children begin their learning by finding out what rocks are and how the three different types of rock are formed. As part of this project, children also find out about fossils and the process of fossilisation. Our history project for this term, focuses on how life changed through the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age. Throughout the term, we will also be completing various DT and art activities.

**HOME LEARNING:**

Children will bring home a reading book and reading diary. These will be linked to your child's reading ability. Reading at home for 10 minutes a day is a great way to support your child's learning. Please record this in your child's reading diary.

Children will also be asked to practise spellings weekly and these will be given out on a Monday. A weekly maths task will be set on Teams every Thursday. Home learning can be completed on Teams or in the orange home learning book. Please photograph any work completed in the orange home learning book and upload on to Teams for teachers to see.

**REMINDERS:**

- Please make sure your child has a named water bottle in school each day.
- Please remember to name all school uniform as it makes it much easier to find any items lost in school.
